

The Wall was dismantled with temporary barriers put up. These have fallen over in the past 4 years and as well as safety aspects it is unsightly. SS has reported this several times to Cumbria Highways and it was discussed the Parish Council funding a permanent repair. It is unclear who owns the original wall and research will be done into this prior to going forward,
