DISTRICT & COUNTY REPORTS

05/11/19 **Discussed** – Ian was advising on the ongoing battles with the local Public Service routes. These have always been a vital lifeline for some members of our Local Communities it's a work in progress to hopefully restore Bus Routes going forwards in Local Areas.

06/11/19 **Discussed** – Sue's Report advised that a planned Meeting with Highways England has been postponed until January. The Wall by the Whitewater Bridge has been at last rebuilt properly by CCC. The County and both Healthcare Authorities are working on a Statement of Action to improve Services for special educational needs & disabilities. It has been accepted by OFSTED and CQC and work is underway to address some of the issues. There is still considerable underfunding in these areas.

- 10/11/19** **Resolved** – A Cheque for £1,200.00 is to be given to the Brow Edge Park Committee for maintenance & ongoing Improvements to the King George V Playing Field.
- 11/11/19** **Discussed** – Street Lighting at Locksfield & nr Anglers – all authorised for repair. Any other faults to be reported with location details for repairs (AN)
- 12/11/19** **Discussed** – Litter Bins on A590 discussed again. We have been awaiting advice from SLDC on whether the Parish can action these due to access & emptying regulations. This will be chased up and Ian Wharton has advised contacts for progression on roadside recycling.
- 13/11/19** **Discussed** – Overgrown foliage in the Village causing pedestrian Issues is to be followed up & actioned.
- 14/11/19** **Discussed** – The Iron Works. Roadside Parking near the School causing issues for oncoming cars and pavement users. Also the Right of Way through the Site and Residential issues not adhering to Planning Conditions were to be followed up by SS through the National Park Planning Authority & their SLDC representative.
- 15/11/19** **Proposed** – Low Wood is to have a new Notice Board & Bench. This will be with thanks & help from Funding available from LDNP (AN)


